

Instructions for North Dakota 4-H Foundation Scholarship Applications



All scholarship application forms are due at the Center for 4-H Youth Development, NDSU, 219 FLC, Fargo, ND 58105 on **March 1**.

Several scholarships are available for 4-H and former 4-H members. **Youth may apply for more than one scholarship using the same application** by checking the blank next to the scholarship(s) for which they wish to be considered on the first page of the application form.

Eligibility for North Dakota 4-H Foundation Scholarships

Scholarship candidates must be:

- A high school senior or accepted or enrolled as an undergraduate at an accredited post secondary school. Maximum age is 21 as of Sept. 1 of the current 4-H year.
- A current or former North Dakota 4-H member.
- A North Dakota 4-H member for at least one year at the time they apply.

Certain scholarships may have additional special eligibility or selection requirements (*see page 2*).

Information Required as Part of Your Application

To be considered as a scholarship candidate, you must include the following items in your application:

- The scholarship application form, completely filled out, with all required signatures. A word processor or computer may be used to complete the application. Please type or print using black ink. For attachments, use plain white 8½-inch by 11-inch paper. Stay within the page limits specified for this section of the form.
- A copy of your current transcript.

Use of Information

The information given on this form is confidential. Demographic, academic, financial and 4-H information will be used only by the Center for 4-H Youth Development to evaluate candidates for North Dakota 4-H Foundation scholarships and will not be released to any other individual or organization. Personal information about scholarship winners may be used in local publicity and news releases. Winners may be asked to submit a recent photo for publicity. A brief note is also sent to sponsors.

North Dakota 4-H Foundation in Memory of Erwin Klusmann and John Norgaard	1 - \$350	Present or former North Dakota 4-H member.
Jerome Striegel Memorial	1 - \$150	North Dakota 4-H member selected as an alternate to attend National 4-H Congress and/or National 4-H Conference.
Rosevold Memorial	1 - \$400	North Dakota 4-H member or former member who will be enrolled in a North Dakota post-secondary school in the fall.
Farm & Ranch Guide	1 - \$250	Current or former 4-H member entering a North Dakota university or college as a freshman. Selection to be based on academic potential and 4-H participation.
William Bloom Scholarship	1 - \$100	Contact the Stark County Extension office. (Stark County ONLY)
John DeKrey Jr. and Hannah DeKrey Award	1 - \$500	Current or former North Dakota 4-H member entering a North Dakota university or college as a freshman. Preference given to applicants from Kidder County.
John D. Paulson Memorial Award	2 - \$1,000 awards	Scholarships will be awarded to students who have been involved in 4-H in Walsh County, N.D. Applicants may pursue their education at a vocational school, technical school, college or university. One of the awards will show preference to first-year students.
Kelci Jo Willson Memorial Award	1 - \$300	Scholarship will be awarded to a current or former North Dakota 4-H member who is entering or continuing his/her education at a vocational school, technical school, college or university.
