

Static Exhibit Committee Meeting
February 19th 2009

The Burleigh Breeze was reviewed and changes were made concerning the date and times of the Static Exhibit Event and clarifying the procedure for check in times the day of judging.

We discussed having clubs do activities throughout the day again like we did last year. It will be posted in the news letter for clubs to start coming up with ideas. Marie Horning has agreed to be the contact person for arranging the activities. We are looking into finding carnival games that can be rented or borrowed from another organization for the day.

Darcy was going to check with Cathy about setting up something with the radio station to broadcast live on July 11th. Mitzi is checking on clothes racks to display projects.

We also discussed having a Grand and Reserve champion table again like we have in the past. The committee talked about having a ribbon table where the 4-Her's would go after their project has been judged instead of the judge giving them the ribbon. This way we can make sure the ribbons are attached more securely to the project.

The Static Exhibit Committee is looking for ideas on how to display the club banners that day.

The committee discussed the issue with changing lot numbers the morning of registration. It was decided not to allow any changes that morning. This would cause too much confusion for the judges on whether or not they are done judging because a new lot number may put the exhibitor with a new judge. It will also make a lot of work for the registration desk trying to make all the necessary changes. Exhibit tags would be wrong also.

It was brought up a few days after the meeting that when judging is done, we could invite community artists or crafters to bring in displays that could be set up in the building for demonstrations or just to show off their work. We may even want to try and utilize the arena for something. The idea is to let people either do a demonstration of their product or sell their products. In emailing the Static Exhibit Committee members, the response from members that it was a good idea and we will discuss it more at our next meeting. This may attract more public to come for the day if they know we have other stuff going on also. We do have several people that are interested in setting something up that day.
