

Federal Funds to North Dakota Counties, 1999

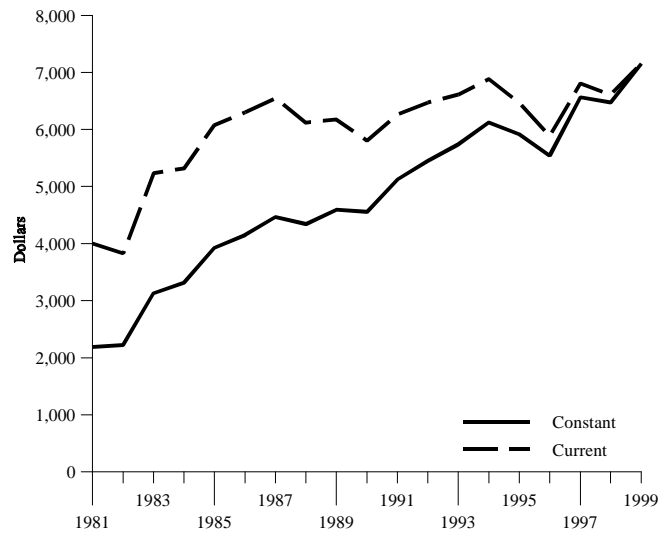
Per capita federal expenditures in North Dakota were \$7,157 in 1999, up 8.2 percent from 1998 after adjustment for inflation. North Dakota ranked 6th in the nation in per capita federal expenditures in 1999.

Federal dollars to North Dakota totaled \$4.5 billion in 1999, 26.9 percent of which was paid directly to individuals for Federal retirement and disability payments (down slightly from 28 percent in 1998).

The largest category of federal expenditures was "other" which accounted for nearly 32 percent of all expenditures, or roughly \$1.4 billion. Within this category, agricultural program payments represented 56 percent of \$805 million.

Defense expenditures in North Dakota totaled \$545 million in 1999, an increase of 14.3 percent from 1998. Defense expenditures accounted for 12 percent of total expenditures to North Dakota in 1999, basically unchanged from 1998.

Data for 'grants' represent the Federal obligation incurred at the time the grant was awarded. Therefore the amounts do not represent actual expenditures. Also, initial amounts may be adjusted through deobligations resulting in negative amounts. 'Procurement' refers to governmental purchases and contractual outlays. Examples of 'other' expenditures include crop insurance, flood insurance, insurance premiums for Federal employee life and health insurance, housing assistance, and student loan programs. Military, postal employee, FBI, and other payroll expenditures are included in the 'salaries' category.
