

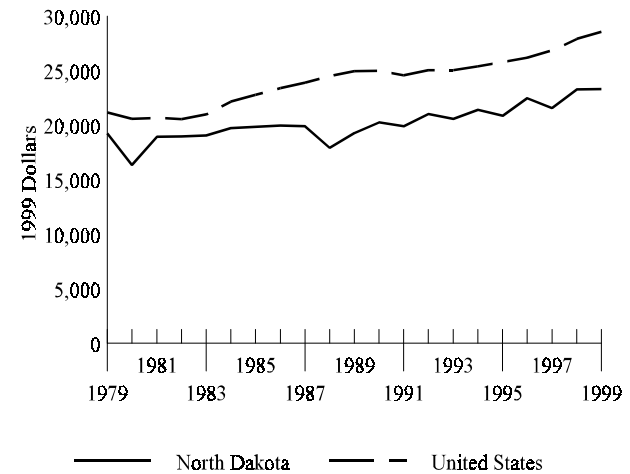
Total and Per Capita Personal Income in North Dakota: 1995-1999

North Dakota per capita personal income grew 2.4 percent in 1999 to \$23,313, after growing 9.5 percent in 1998. Prices paid by consumers (as measured by the Consumer Price Index) increased 2.2 percent in 1999 after increasing 1.6 percent in 1998. All 50 states and the District of Columbia had growth rates in per capita income that were at or above the increases in prices in both 1998 and 1999.

Total personal income in North Dakota rose to \$14.8 billion in 1999, up 1.7 percent from \$14.5 billion in 1998.

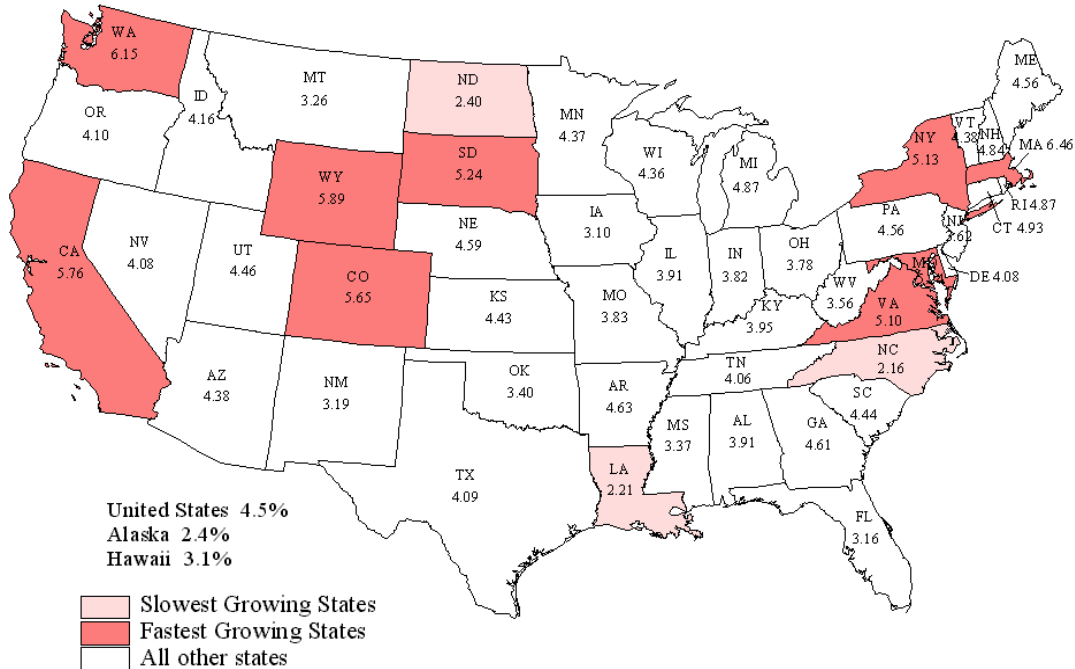
Within North Dakota, the fastest growing non-farm industry between 1998 and 1999 was construction followed by agricultural services/forestry/fishing, and finance, insurance, and real estate (14.1 percent, 11.0 percent, and 7.1 percent, respectively).
