



Tips for **Safe Winter Travel**

Stay tuned to weather forecasts	Keep hoods, lights and windows free of ice and snow
Inform others of your travel plans and schedule	Carry a kit of blankets, food and water and other survival supplies
Keep your fuel tank at least $\frac{3}{4}$ full and use ethanol gasoline or deicer	If you're stalled or stuck, stay with your vehicle
Maintain your vehicle in good condition (snow tires, strong battery, new belts, lighter oil, tune-up)	Use candles and wick heaters carefully and with good ventilation
