

## North Dakotans Living in Group Quarters: 2000

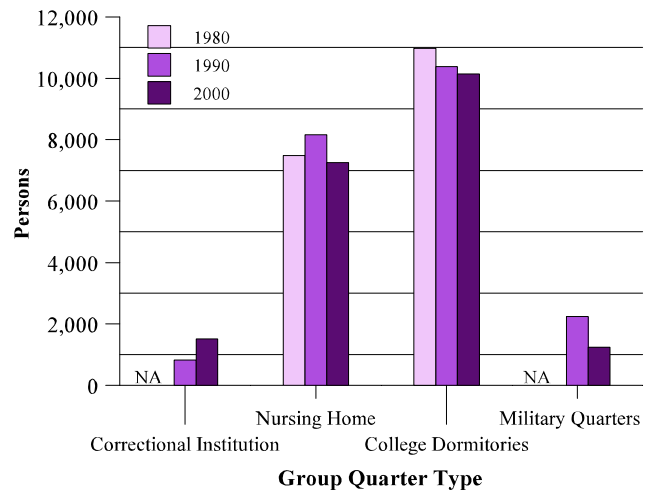
According to the 2000 Census, North Dakota had a total population of 642,200. Of these persons, a majority (96.3 percent) lived in households. The remaining 3.7 percent (23,631 persons) resided in group quarter facilities. Nearly 9,700 persons lived in institutionalized arrangements such as correctional facilities or nursing homes. Approximately 14,000 lived in noninstitutional settings such as college dormitories or military barracks.

The number of persons living in group quarters in North Dakota declined 2.5 percent between 1990 and 2000.

Nationally, North Dakota had the 3<sup>rd</sup> highest proportion of persons living in group quarters. In South Dakota, 3.8 percent of persons were residing in group quarters, placing it first in the nation. Rhode Island followed at 3.7 percent.

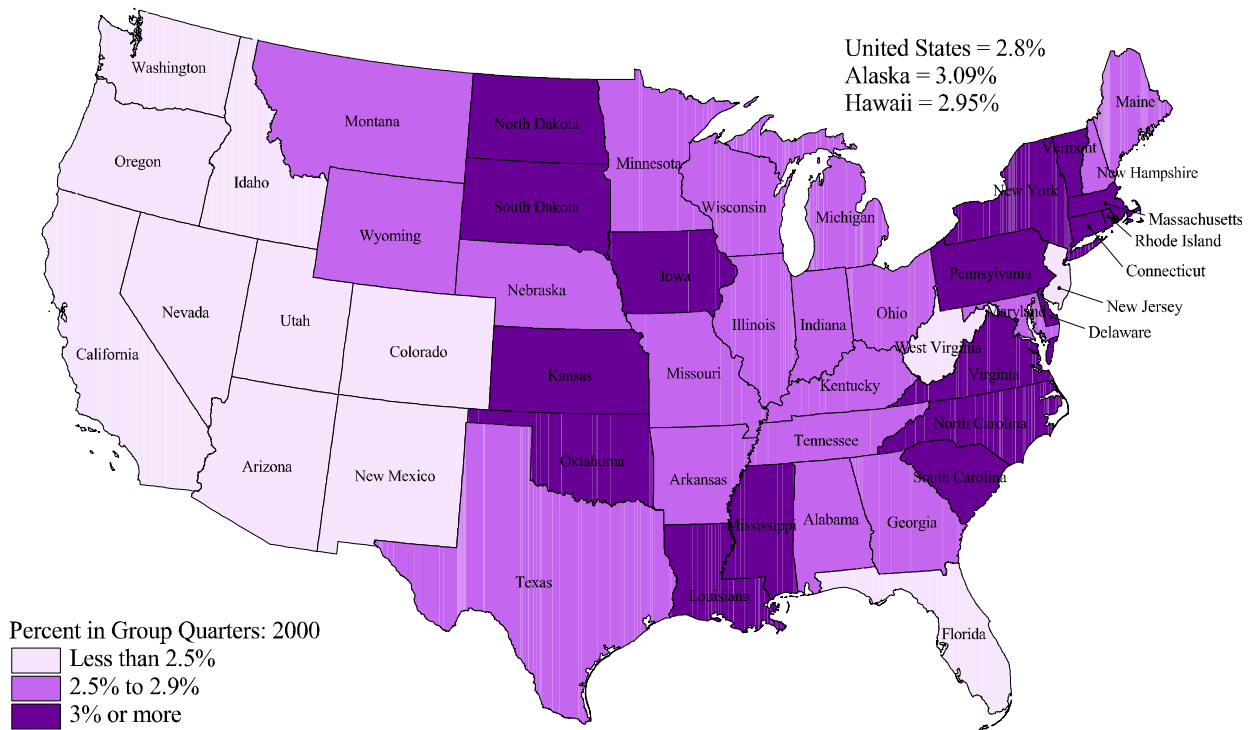
**Persons in Group Quarters by Select Type**
