

North Dakota Gross State Product: 2000

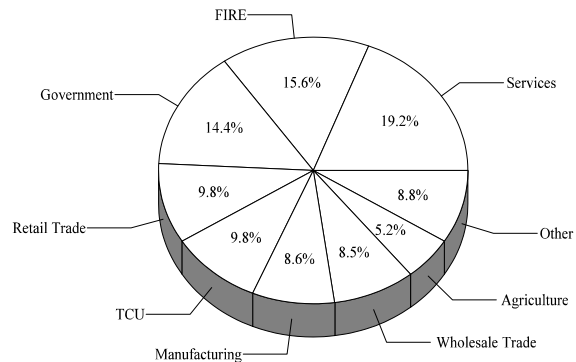
North Dakota's gross state product totaled \$18.3 billion in 2000. Its share of the U.S. total was 0.2 percent, one of the smallest shares in the nation. Three states comprised nearly 30 percent of the U.S. total; California (13.5 percent), New York (8.0 percent), and Texas (7.5 percent).

The service industry accounted for the largest share of North Dakota's gross state product in 2000 (19.2 percent). Finance, Insurance, and Real Estate (FIRE) followed at 15.6 percent with Government third at 14.4 percent. The construction sector, which contributed 5 percent to North Dakota's gross state product, showed the largest growth - more than doubling over the last ten years.

According to the Bureau of Economic Analysis, gross state product, often considered the state counterpart of the nation's gross domestic product, is the value added in production by the labor and property located in the state.

Gross State Product by Industry in North Dakota: 2000

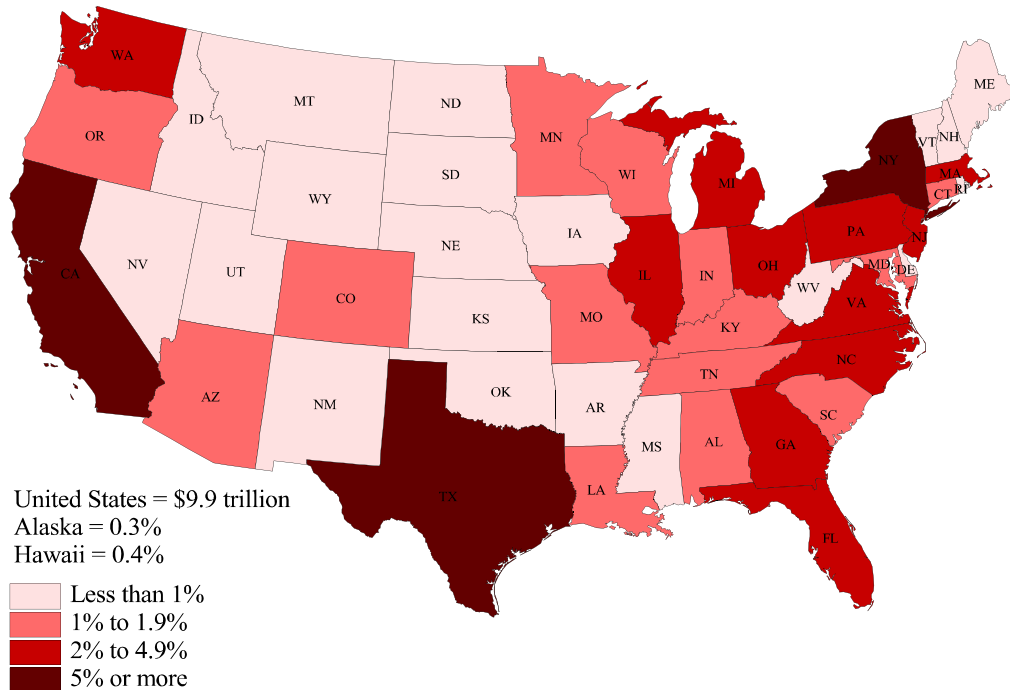
Percents based on current dollar values
