

Business Establishments in North Dakota: 2000

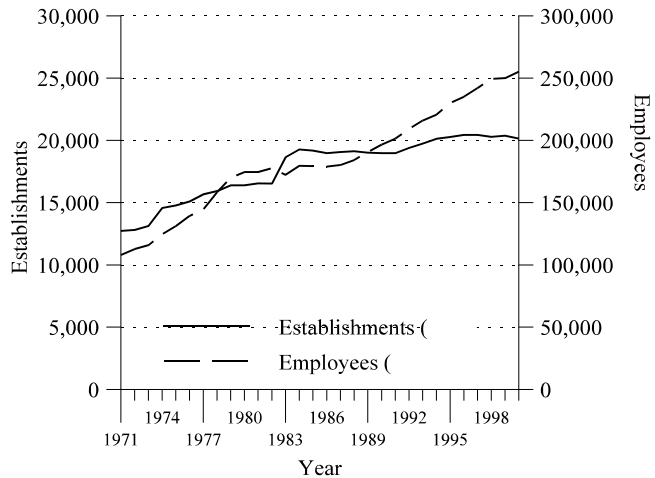
The number of businesses in North Dakota declined 1.2 percent between 1999 and 2000, from 20,380 establishments to 20,139.

The number of employees in North Dakota businesses increased from 250,292 in 1999 to 255,178 in 2000, an increase of 4,886 employees or 2.0 percent.

Annual payroll for businesses in North Dakota rose from \$5.8 billion in 1999 to \$6.1 billion in 2000, an increase of \$268 million or 4.6 percent.

The businesses included in this bulletin are only those covered by the Federal Insurance Contributions Act (FICA). Self-employed persons, domestic service workers, railroad employees, agricultural production workers, most government employees on ocean-borne vessels or in foreign countries are excluded.

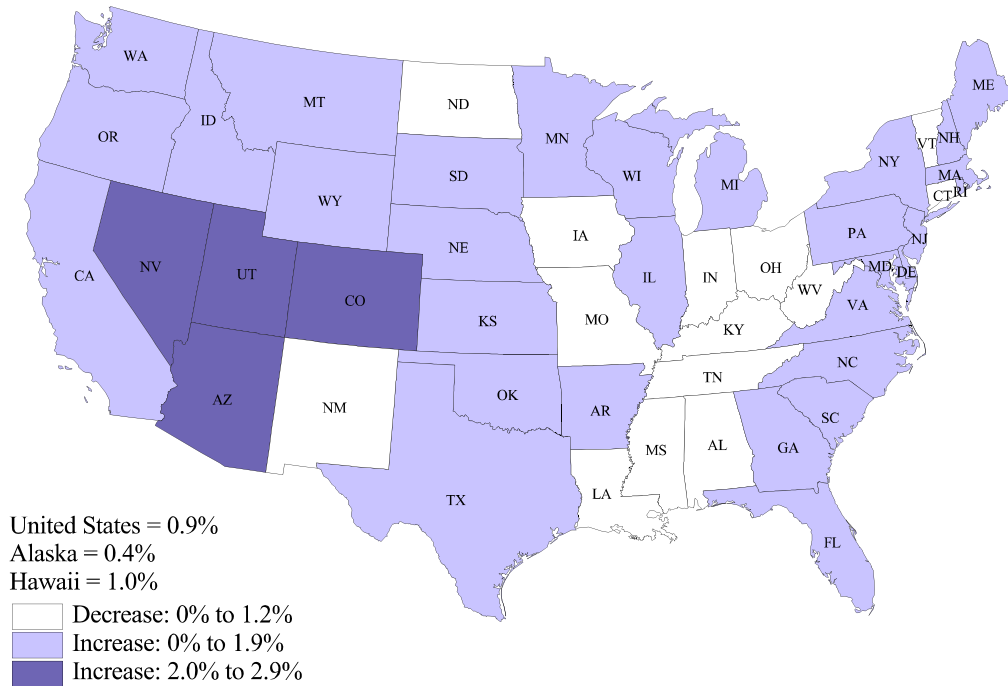
Business Establishments and Employees:
