

Business Establishments in North Dakota: 2001

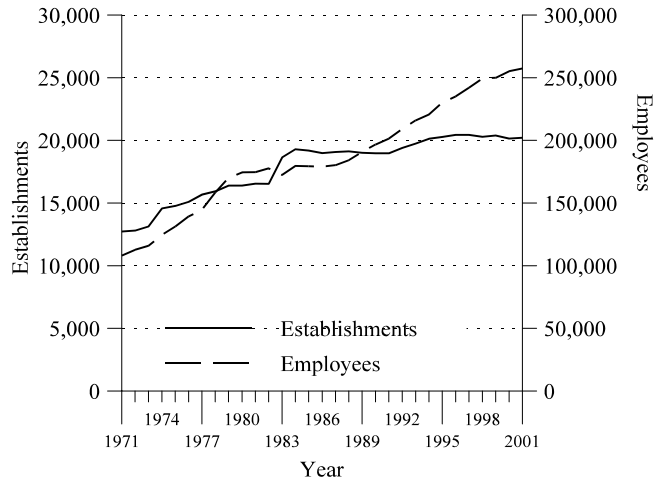
The number of businesses in North Dakota totaled 20,206 in 2001, rising less than half a percent from 20,139 establishments in 2000.

Private sector employment for the state, as of March 2001, was 257,335 compared with 255,178 in March 2000. Annual payroll per employee was \$25,012, up 5.4 percent from \$23,737 the year before, while annual total payroll for the state was \$6.4 billion, up 6.3 percent from \$6.1 billion in 2000.

The services sector employed the largest portion of the state's private workforce at 41.3 percent, with an average annual payroll per employee of \$20,729.

The businesses included in this bulletin are only those covered by the Federal Insurance Contributions Act (FICA). Self-employed persons, domestic service workers, railroad employees, agricultural production workers, most government employees on ocean-borne vessels or in foreign countries are excluded.

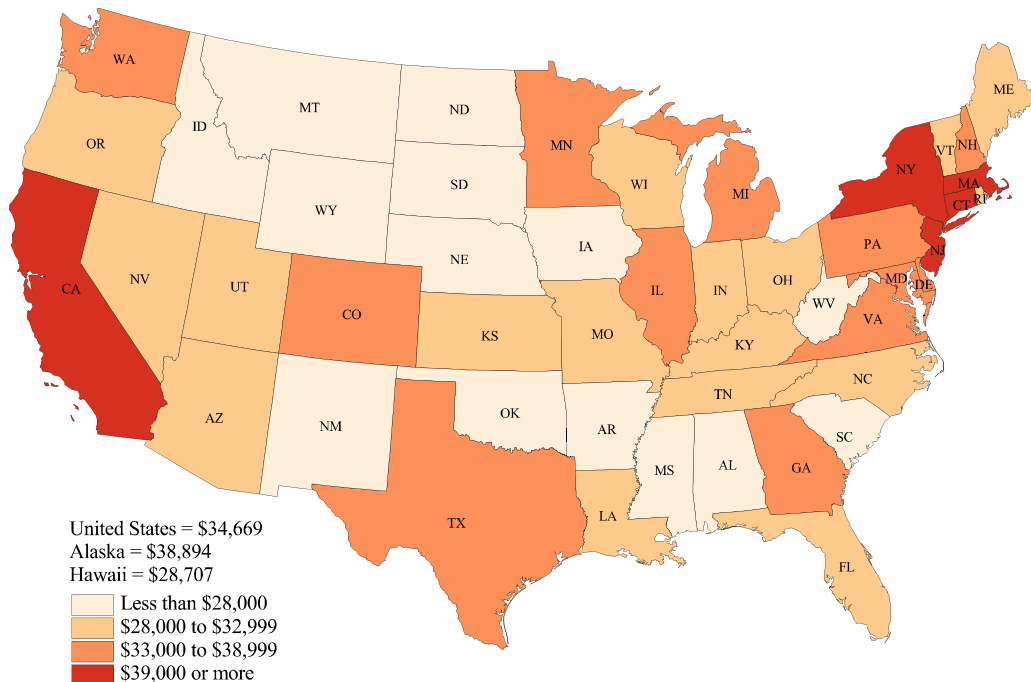
Business Establishments and Employees:
