

# Temperature Danger Zones

Temperature	What to Do/What Happens
150 F	Measure temperature daily
160 F	Measure temperature every four hours; inspect stack
175 F	Prepare to call fire department; wet hay, remove from barn or dismantle stack away from buildings and other dry hay
185 F	Hot spots/pockets possible; flames likely when heating hay comes in contact with air
212 F	Temperature rises rapidly; hay almost certainly will ignite; pockets already may have burned under surface;
