The Center of Life and Food Sciences Weihenstephan at the Technische Universität München (TUM) invites applications for the position of

Chair of Agricultural and Food Economics (W3)

to be filled at earliest convenience.

Applications are invited from candidates with an excellent international academic record in agricultural and food economics, in particular on topics related to the agribusiness sector. The successful candidate is able to show a record of work, e.g. on market structure analysis, economics and management of innovation, or supply chain management. Candidates should be willing to engage in interdisciplinary projects of the Center of Life and Food Sciences Weihenstephan, in particular within the Hans-Eisenmann Center for Agricultural Sciences. Initiatives to cooperate with the TUM Business School are expected.

Teaching is required in undergraduate and graduate programs of the Center of Life and Food Sciences Weihenstephan, in particular in the programs of agricultural sciences and horticultural sciences, and in related fields.

Preconditions for employment are a degree from a university or an accredited college of applied science, pedagogical aptitude, Ph.D./doctorate and a postdoctoral lecturing and research qualification (Habilitation) or an equivalent academic achievement, which may have been obtained as a junior professor or outside a university environment. At the time of appointment applicants should not be older than 52 years. Under certain circumstances the age limit may be lifted.

In cases of substantially equal eligibility, preferential consideration will be given to disabled candidates.

As part of the Excellence Initiative of the German federal and state governments, the Technische Universität München pursues the strategic goal of substantially increasing the proportion of women in research and education and thus expressly invites qualified female scientists to apply for this position.
